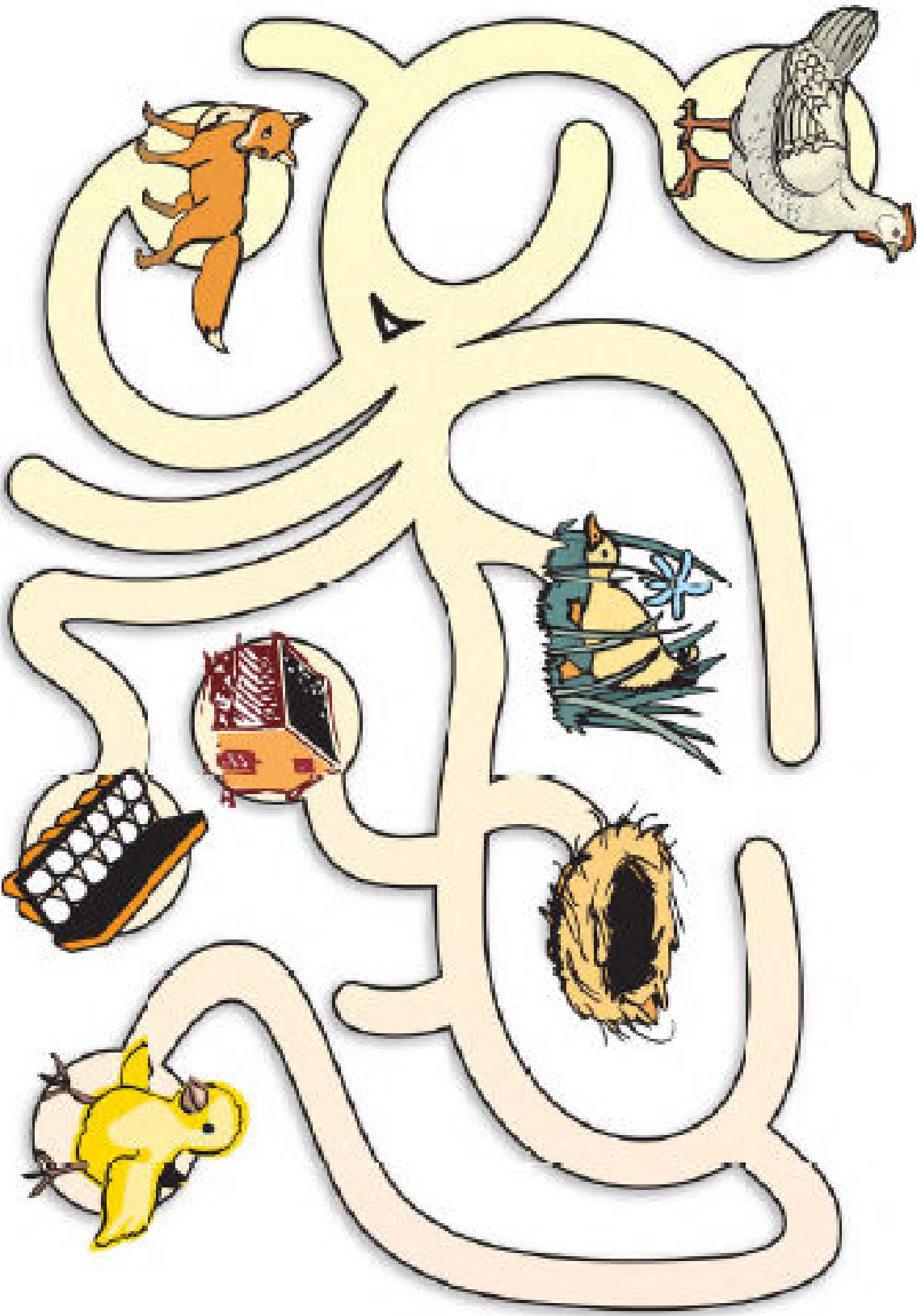

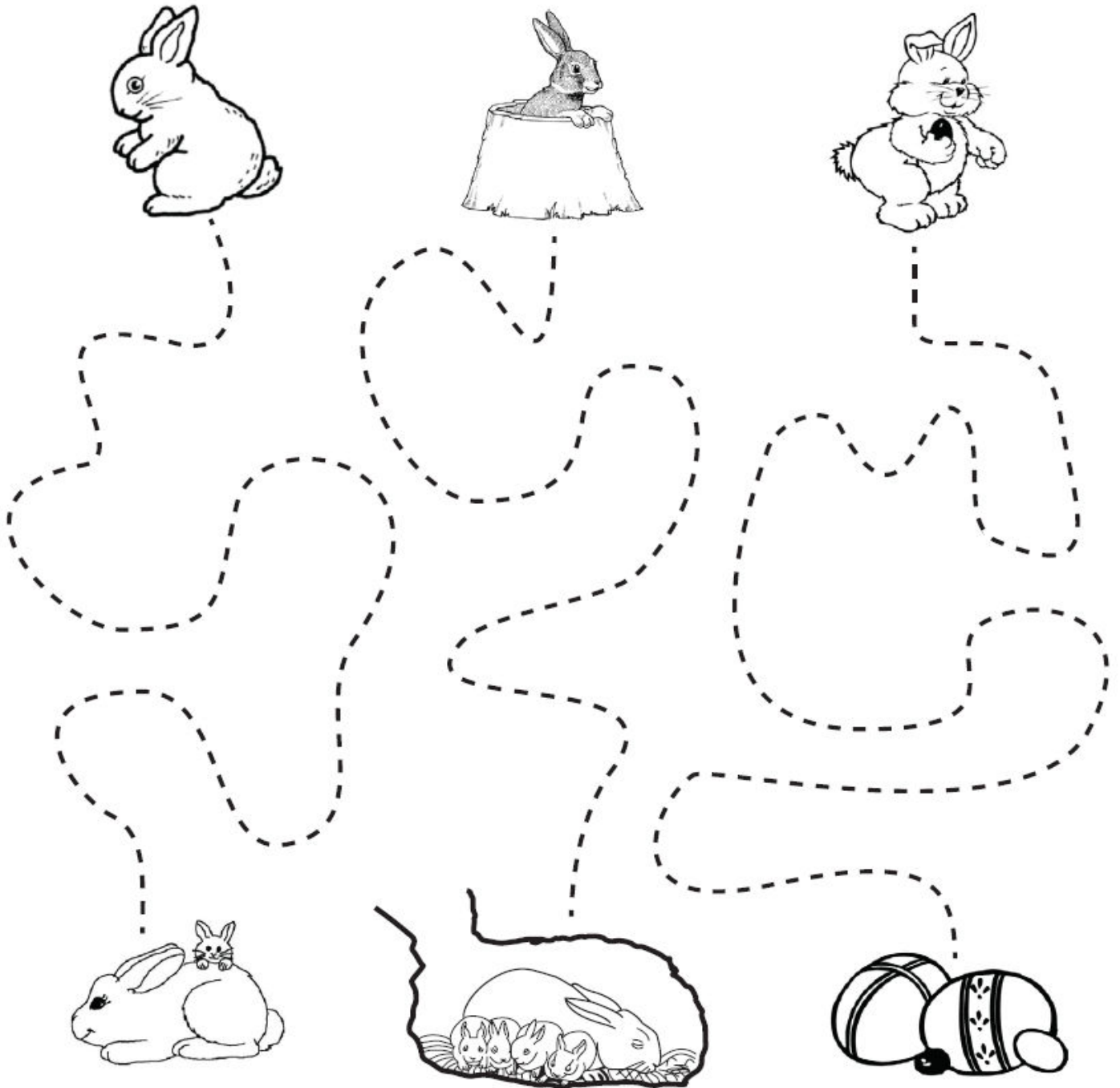

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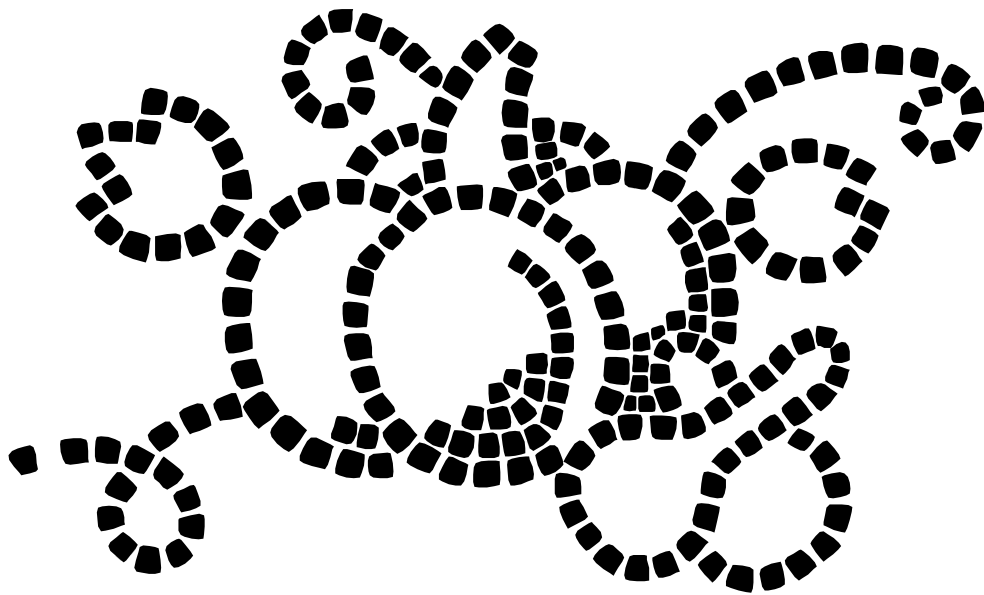

2. Use as many different kinds of seeds as possible to create a beautiful harvest picture.



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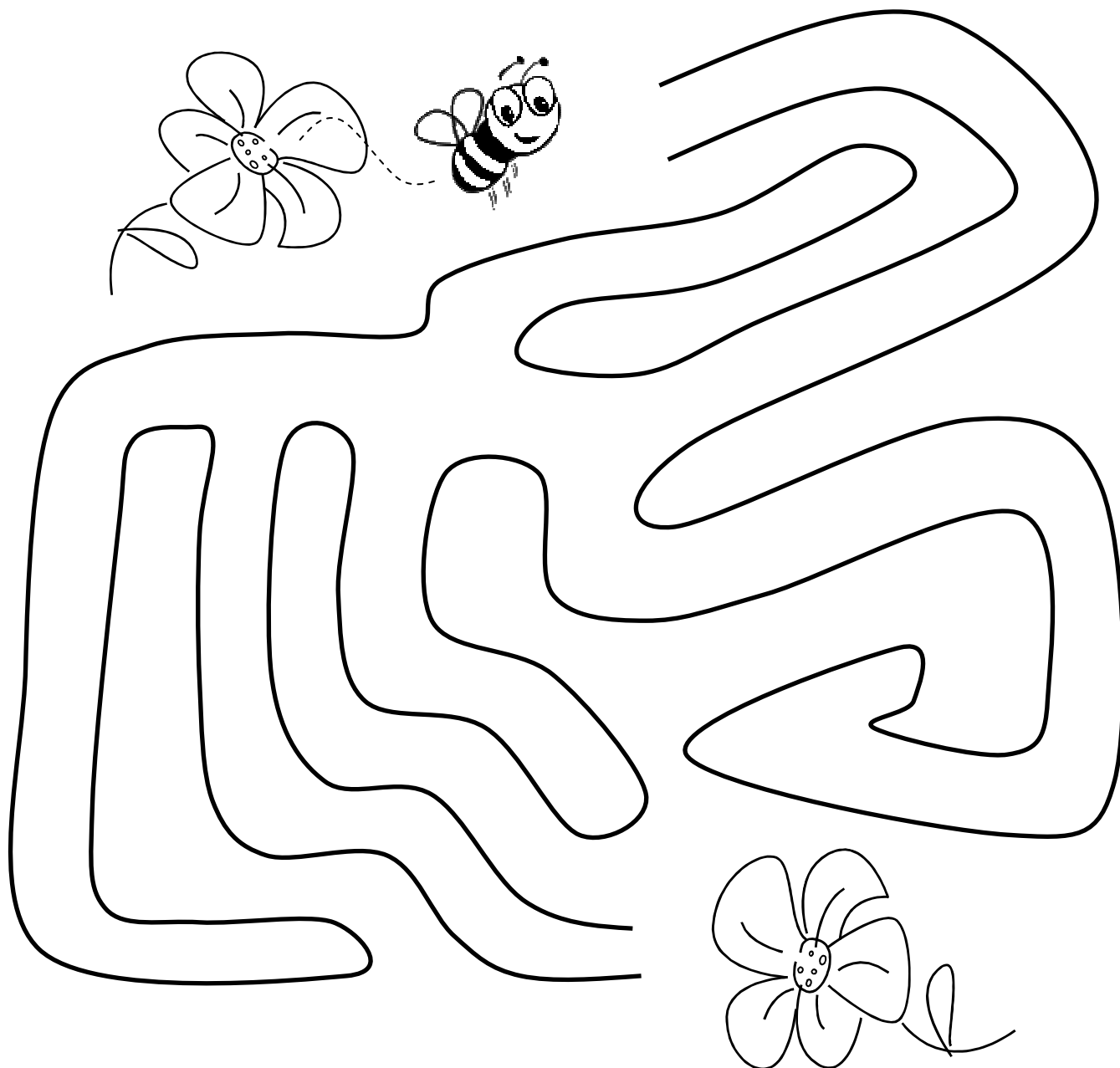

The chick climbs out once the shell breaks apart.



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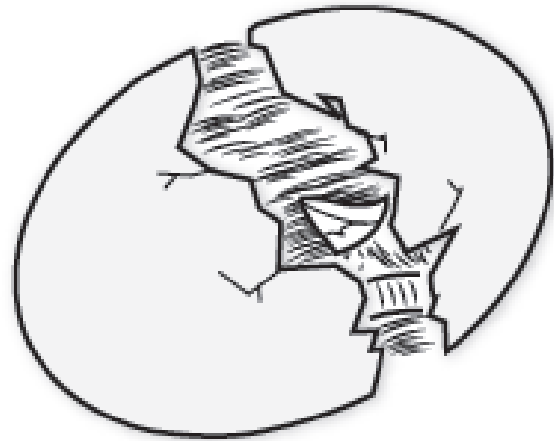

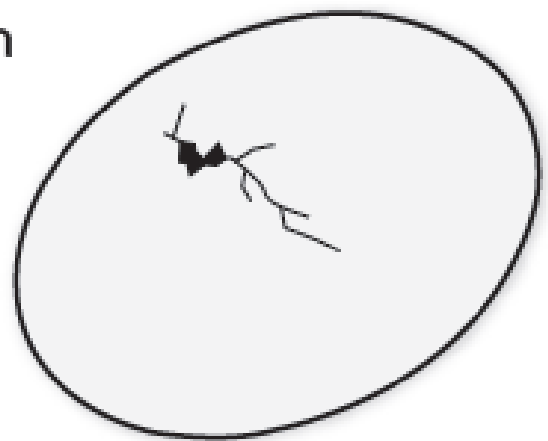
The chick is very tired from its work.
It rests while its feathers dry.



The chick pushes with its
head and feet to widen
the crack in the shell.

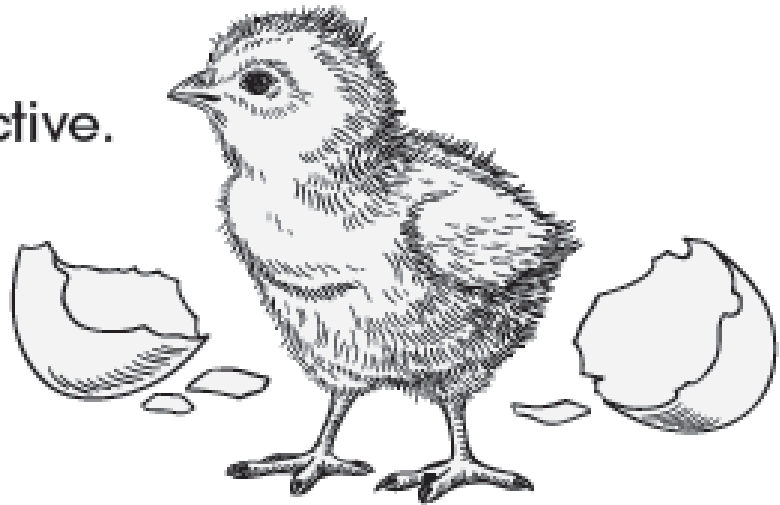


The chick uses a special tooth
on its beak called an "egg
tooth" to peck a hole in the
shell. This is very hard work
for the chick and it rests
often while it is hatching.

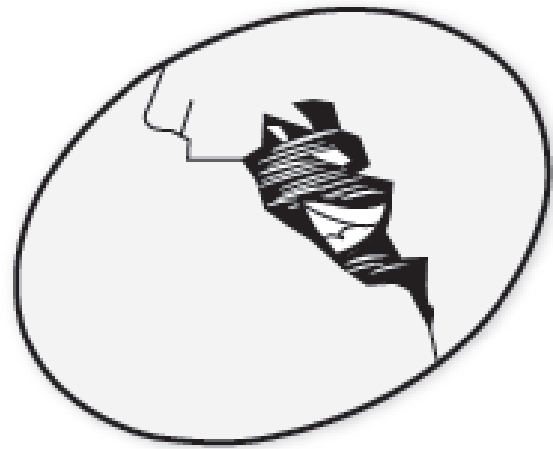




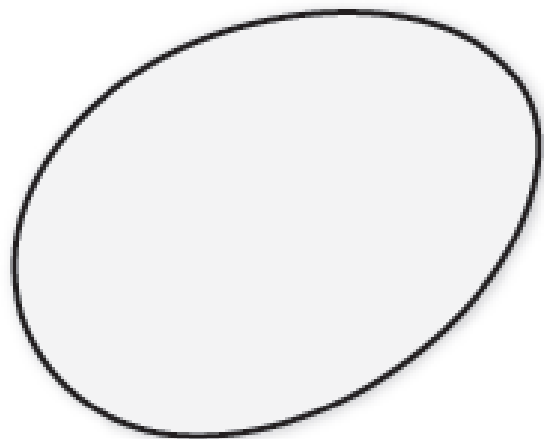
Two hours later, the chick is fluffy and active. It will be fully grown in six months.



The chick pecks at the shell until it is cracked all the way around.



It takes twenty-one days for a chick embryo to grow inside a fertile egg. The chick only grows inside an egg that has been kept warm by a hen or in an incubator.

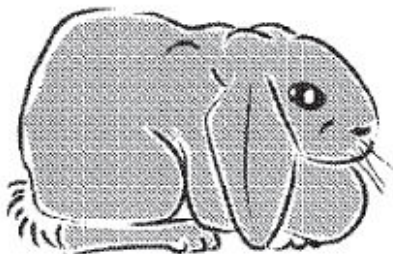
